

TERMINATION OF DECLARATION OF DISASTER

WHEREAS, on October 11, 2024, the County Judge, pursuant to the Texas Government Code, Chapter 418, the "Texas Disaster Act", issued a proclamation declaring a local state of disaster for the County of Polk due to dry conditions, lack of significant rainfall, and the threat of wildfire;

WHEREAS, the Polk County Commissioners Court extended the Declaration of Disaster for a period of thirty days on October 17, 2024;

WHEREAS, the conditions necessitating the proclamation of a local state of disaster have ceased to exist; and

WHEREAS, the Texas Disaster Act provides that a local state of disaster may be terminated by the governing body of the political subdivision or by executive order of the County Judge;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED BY THE COMMISSIONERS COURT:

The Commissioners Court, as the governing body of Polk County, hereby terminates the proclamation of a local state of disaster described in the preamble above.
